

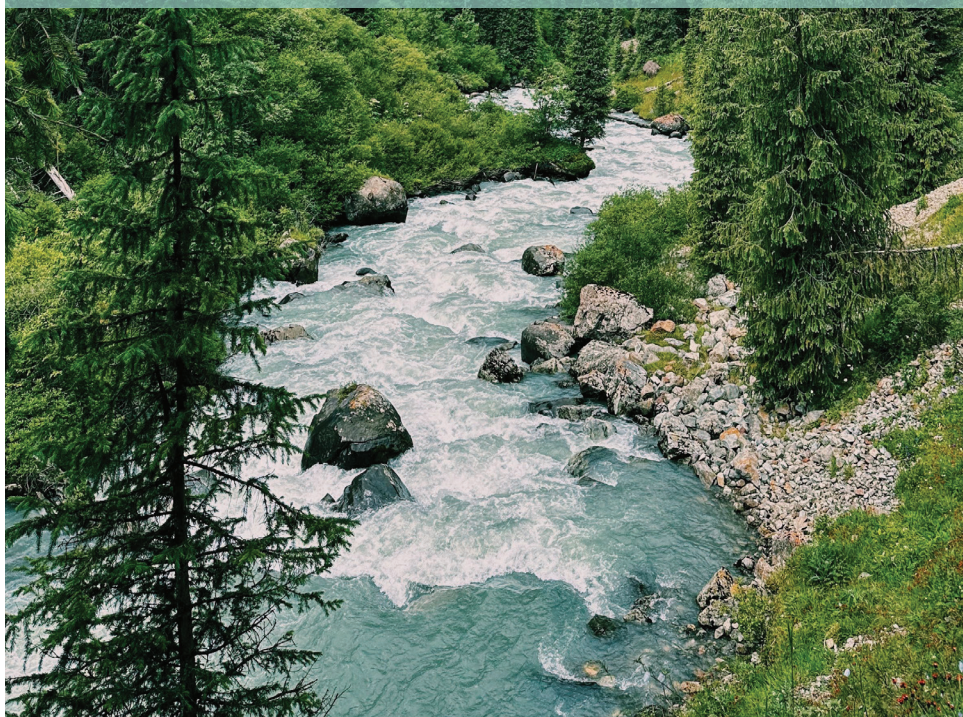

PART II: THE TEST OF FELLOWSHIP

PART TWO: BROUGHT NEAR THROUGH CHRIST

The gospel announces more than forgiveness. It is the good news that, through the death and resurrection of Jesus, sinners are brought near to God, reconciled to Him, and united with His Son. Christianity is not merely accepting a message or adopting a moral code. It is receiving Christ Himself: our Savior, Shepherd, righteousness, and a life now and the eternal to come.

Paul describes this astonishing reconciliation: **“For if when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation”** (Romans 5:10-11).

We were enemies, but God reconciled us. We were separated, yet through Christ we have been brought near. We were under death, yet now we are saved by His life. The gospel offers not merely a cleared record, but restored communion with the living God. Forgiveness opens the way to

fellowship, and fellowship becomes the atmosphere in which faith matures.

Knowing Christ is not merely one spiritual priority among many; it is the essence of Christian life. Fellowship with Him is the source of obedience, the anchor of faith, and the meaning of every spiritual practice. We read Scripture to hear His voice and behold His glory. We pray because we have access to the Father through Him. We gather with the church because we belong to His body. We serve because His love compels us. We witness because He lives.

Everything finds its proper place here. Spiritual disciplines are not substitutes for Christ; they are means by which we seek, enjoy, and respond to Him. Good works are not performances meant to secure His acceptance; they are fruit of union with Him. Eternal life begins with knowing Him, continues as we abide in Him, and will be fulfilled when we see Him face to face. Christ is not merely the doorway into Christianity. He is its deepest treasure, its sustaining presence, and its final joy.
