THE SURPASSING WORTH of knowing Christ

PART I: THE REORDERING OF VALUE

PART ONE: WHEN GAIN BECOMES LOSS

Earlier this month in Christianity is a Relationship, not a Religion, we've seen that Christianity is not merely a system to practice but a living relationship with Jesus Christ. Jesus defines eternal life as knowing **"the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent"** (John 17:3). If knowing Christ stands at the center of eternal life, a searching question follows: How highly do we truly value Him?

Paul answers with remarkable clarity in Philippians 3. Before his conversion, he possessed every source of religious confidence. He had heritage, discipline, knowledge, zeal, and reputation. If acceptance with God could be earned through human achievement, Paul had assembled an impressive case. He could look at his record and find reasons for confidence.

Then Paul encountered the risen Christ, and the value of everything changed. Looking back on the accomplishments that once defined him, he writes, **"But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ"** (Philippians 3:7). This was not a minor adjustment to his priorities. It was a complete reversal. What Paul had once

counted as gain was moved to the loss column because a greater treasure had appeared.

Paul explains, **"Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord"** (Philippians 3:8). Other translations render this as "the surpassing worth" of knowing Christ. That phrase is decisive. Paul is not claiming that heritage, learning, discipline, or service have no value. He is declaring that none of them can compare with Christ or serve as the foundation for his identity before God.

This is what happens when Jesus is rightly seen. He does not merely become a valuable part of an otherwise unchanged life. His worth reorders everything. Good gifts remain good, but they are no longer ultimate. Achievements may be appreciated, responsibilities faithfully carried out, and relationships deeply loved, yet none can occupy Christ's place. Genuine conversion does more than revise our beliefs. Christ reshapes our loves, redirects our confidence, and becomes the treasure by which every other treasure is measured.
