THE SURPASSING WORTH of knowing Christ

PART I: THE REORDERING OF VALUE

PART TWO: FOUND IN CHRIST

Paul's reordering of value extends beyond religious credentials. Everyone builds life around something: career, family, ministry, influence, security, comfort, or approval. Many are God's gracious gifts to receive and steward wisely. The danger arises when a good thing becomes ultimate, bearing the weight of our identity, peace, and hope. No created gift can bear that burden. Only Jesus Christ can carry that weight.

Paul goes beyond changing priorities. He says he **"suffered the loss of all things"** and counted them as refuse **"that I may gain Christ and be found in Him"** (Philippians 3:8-9). Knowing Christ is not added to an already secure identity. Christ becomes his foundation, righteousness, and belonging. The old grounds of confidence are relinquished because something better has been received.

To be "found in Him" speaks of union. Paul no longer stands before God clothed in personal achievement or "having my own righteousness, which is from the law." Instead, he rests in **"that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by**

faith" (Philippians 3:9). This is the heart of the gospel: believers are accepted not because their record is sufficient, but because Christ is. His righteousness, not ours, becomes our confidence.

This truth not only corrects theology; it liberates the soul. The burden of self-justification lifts. We no longer need to craft a flawless identity, protect an image, or prove we deserve acceptance. In Christ, we are received by His obedience and grace. Work can become service rather than a means of self-protection. We can enjoy our successes without making them idols, and face our failures without letting them become verdicts.

The surpassing worth of knowing Christ is revealed not only in what Paul believed but also in what he was willing to give up. The question for us is equally personal: What am I asking to give me the worth, security, or righteousness that can be found only in Jesus? Whatever competes with Him must be reordered, because gaining Christ is never a loss. He is our righteousness, our freedom, and our incomparable treasure.

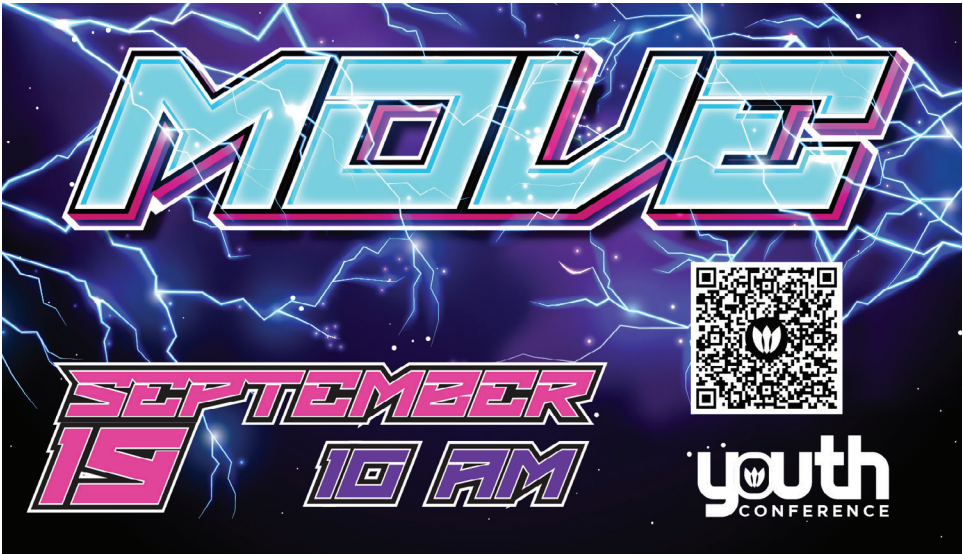
